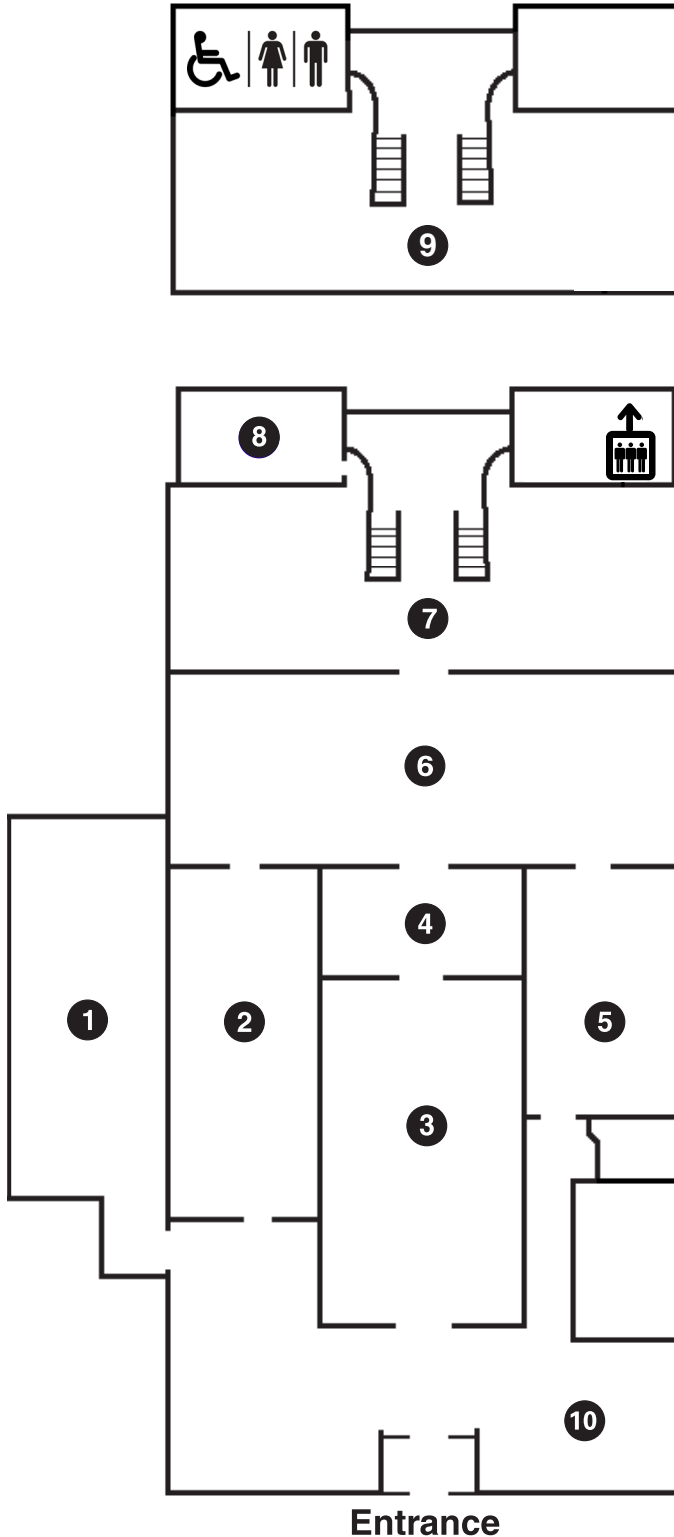
## Welcome
